The most engaged participant will have the opportunity to select a Los Angeles fire disaster relief fund of their choice, and we will donate \$200 on their behalf.

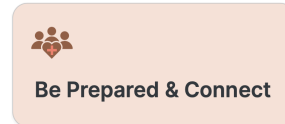
2) Attend the Kickoff Zoom Session
